Kambarang

Kambarang, the Noongar season synonymous with the wildflower season, heralds a time of birth and vibrant hues. It is a season when nature bursts forth in an array of colours — from the golden yellows of acacias to the delicate blossoms of kangaroo paw and orchids. The landscape becomes a canvas, with banksias, balgas, and other flora contributing to the masterpiece.

In the heart of the city, this natural spectacle is mirrored on our urban screens. Rich documentaries bring Forrest Place and the Northbridge Piazza alive, reflecting the myriad colours of wildflowers that grace Kings Park (Kaarta Koomba) and the vast Western Australian coast. As Kambarang signals the transition from the cold grasp of winter to the embrace of warmth, the City's arts and culture scene also transforms — unveiling a rich tapestry of exhibitions and performances.

This season's Kambarang Screen Exhibition Program celebrates a diverse spectrum of artistry — spanning portraiture, painting, glass, and sculpture, as well as jewellery, textiles, and woodwork.

We proudly present works from flagship institutions such as PICA, The Art Gallery of Western Australia, and The Lester Prize, among others. Featured works by Ikuntji Artists offer a glimpse into the richness and diversity of language and culture from the Luritja people of Haasts Bluff, now on display on city screens.

The warming weather of Kambarang brings open-air screenings and events, with the ever-popular Free Flicks for Kids returning to the City Screens — offering free feature films for the whole family in the heart of Northbridge.

This program offers just a glimpse of what the City Screens' continuous program has to share. As we journey through Kambarang, the screens become windows into Perth's flourishing arts and culture, inviting passersby to pause, look up, and discover the creative energy that defines our city.

Noongar Six Seasons

In celebration of Kambarang — the sixth season in the Noongar calendar — the City of Perth presents two meditative 'slow TV' programs that gently transform the urban landscape with the colours, textures, and rhythms of Kambarang.

Colours of Kambarang, our daytime presentation, offers a contemplative journey through Kings Park (Kaarta Koomba) and documents a myriad of native wildflowers currently in bloom. The vivid beauty and life of Perth's natural wonders are paired with seasonal insights about Kambarang from the Kurongkurl Katitjin page on the ECU website, along with the taxonomic and common names of each flower.

As the sun sets, the screen shifts to Yallingup Beach, capturing the sun setting over the sweeping and majestic coast. Surfers bob gently among the waves as the sky transforms. Viewers are invited to experience the shifting light and elemental changes of the season unfolding over land and sea.

Kambarang, a season of flowering and awakening, signals the return of warmth after Djilba's cooler days. These screenings honour this seasonal transformation, encouraging city dwellers and visitors alike to pause and reflect on the deep seasonal patterns of place.

Slow TV as a genre embraces a meditative pace, typically capturing extended, unedited experiences that unfold in real time. It allows viewers to engage with content that celebrates the intrinsic beauty of the everyday. Originating in Norway with broadcasts such as a seven-hour train journey, Slow TV has gained a global audience, inviting viewers to find relaxation and mindfulness in the unhurried observation of life's simple moments. This genre offers a tranquil alternative to the fast-paced narratives of mainstream media, encouraging audiences to slow down and connect with the serenity of prolonged, immersive footage.

Ikuntji Artists

Stories are still being recounted of long journeys of people from various language groups, who travelled from rockholes and waterholes to caves and mountains, finally arriving at Haasts Bluff. The local Luritja people were already here. Thus, Haasts Bluff is a community rich in diversity of language and culture.

Ikuntji Artists was first established in 1992. The artists draw their inspiration from their personal ngurra (country) and Tjukurrpa (Dreaming). They interpret the ancestral stories by using traditional symbols, icons and motifs. The artistic repertoire of Ikuntji Artists is diverse, encompassing naive and highly abstract paintings, each one told in the artist's personal signature style.

Over the course of more than three decades, the art movement at Ikuntji has flourished, continually leaving its mark on the fine art world. At the same time, the art centre has been the cultural hub of the community, maintaining, reinforcing and reinvigorating cultural practices through art-making.

Today, Haasts Bluff has a population of around 150 people. Ikuntji Artists has eight key artists, who exhibit in Australia and internationally and are represented in significant collections across the globe.

Works from Ikuntji Artists are exhibited daily throughout Kambarang on the City of Perth's Northbridge Piazza Superscreen and Forrest Place's Arts Screen, bringing the rich visual language of the Luritja people to the heart of the city.

The Lester Prize is managed by The Lester Inc., a not-for-profit organisation founded in 2007 to provide an avenue for artists to exhibit works of portraiture in Western Australia.

Each year, The Lester Prize invites locals and visitors to encounter contemporary portraiture in accessible public settings, bringing art directly into the everyday life of the city.



Glass Artists of WA

Glass Artists of Western Australia (GAWA) presents a compelling survey of contemporary glass-making in Western Australia, featuring the work of 20 artists from across the state. First exhibited at Shopfront Gallery Northbridge in June 2025, the digital screen adaptation brings the exhibition into the public realm.

This presentation offers a unique lens into the diversity, innovation, and craftsmanship defining glass art practice in WA today. From bold sculptural forms to delicate explorations of transparency, colour, and light, each piece reflects the distinct artistic voice of its maker, together forming a collective portrait of a vibrant creative field.

Founded in 2014 following the national glass exhibition, Flair at Gallery Central in Perth, GAWA is an active collective of glass artists united by a shared passion for the medium. The group fosters connection, collaboration, and visibility for glass art across WA. Their ongoing exhibitions and events serve as platforms for emerging talent and opportunities for seasoned practitioners to share their evolving craft.


About the screenings
